- o DBVI (Department for the Blind and Visually Impaired) grant
 - Goal is to market this grant to youth as a transition from school to work program. Grant funding for transportation and transition services are obtained.
- Vermont Dual Enrollment Program ((DOE)
 - We are still working on this goal. Our plan is to reach out to Martha Frank to hopefully present more information to us.
- Effects of Long COVID
 - I believe we are still in a research phase, as we acquire more data about the needs of this demographic.
- Deaf and Hard of Hearing Bills in Legislature
 - This bill seeks to include accessibility models in all Vermont schools. This act relates the Education Bill of Rights for children who are deaf, hard of hearing, Or deaf/blind. This act has made crossover to the senate, and is under review?
- Spirit of ADA Awards- Given to nominated employers for their exemplary commitment to creating an inclusive workplace. Their mission is to create equal employment for all Vermonters.

- Process and Outcomes for SCEP (Summer Career Exploration Program)
 - This program has had a successful start in the past few years, however increased difficulties with transportation are imminent, as cuts to public transit happen across the state next year.
