

Directions to the Waterbury State Office Complex

(Note: At this time, OnStar, Google maps, and most GPS units do not show State Drive in Waterbury.)



Coming to Waterbury from the North via I89:

If coming from I89, take Exit 10 (Waterbury Exit) and bear right. Drive into Waterbury Village. At the second traffic light, take a right onto Park Row– this will bring you down a short street, bear left at the end of this street – this is State Drive and where the Waterbury Complex is located.

Drive until you see the big gray building – this is the main entrance to the complex and parking. Come in the front door of the complex and check in at the security window to the right.

Note: Please be sure to arrive a few minutes early, and bring a form of ID with you (a driver's license is acceptable).

Coming to the Waterbury Complex from the South via I89:

If coming from I89, take Exit 10 (Waterbury Exit) and bear left. Drive into Waterbury Village. (Follow the same steps as above)

Coming to the Waterbury Complex from the South via Route 2:

Take Route 2 to Waterbury Village. After the intersection of Route 2 and Route 100 (the intersection is just before crossing the bridge into Waterbury), drive approximately 4/10ths of a mile and take the left onto State Drive (this will be the 2nd street on your left, after the intersection) Continue driving until you see the big gray building – this is the main entrance to the complex. Come in the front door of the complex and check in at the security window to the right.

Note: Please be sure to arrive a few minutes early, and bring a form of ID with you (a driver's license is acceptable).



Waterbury Complex Security Desk – Visitor's Badge

Visitors are required to sign-in and obtain a visitor's badge before they are permitted to access the complex's semi-public main atrium space. Visitors must display a valid photo ID to be issued a badge.

Once signed-in, visitors will be directed to one of four entrances where they must call a department employee who will escort them while they are in the secure area.

ID cards are issued to all employees and all visitors. **Everyone is required to display their ID badge at all times while in the building.** Those without badges displayed may be stopped and questioned by BGS security.

BGS security operates the security desk in the main entrance between 7:00AM-5:00PM, Monday – Friday. They also make rounds through the complex during the day and afterhours.

Complex Facilities and Amenities

The Sally Fox Conference Center is located on the 2nd floor above the main entrance and consists of the Oak, Ash and Cherry conference rooms.

Focus Rooms and small meeting space: If you arrive early for a meeting and would like a private space to meet in a smaller group prior to your meeting, there are several smaller focus rooms off of the atrium that can be used.

Restrooms can be found on both the first floor and second floor in the atrium. Ladies restrooms are to the left and Men's facilities can be found on the right side past the stairs or at the top of the stairs.

Café

Located on the second floor of the atrium area, the Waterbury Café is open Monday – Friday between 7:30AM – 2:00PM (closed on state holidays). In addition to the Café, there is a coffee cart in the main lobby.

The Café features a full breakfast and lunch menu of moderately priced selections. Made-to-order sandwiches and salads, entrées, and daily specials feature healthy options, as well as comfort food favorites. The Café partners with local farmers and vendors to offer as much local fare as possible. Catering and beverage service for conferences and meetings is also available.

The Waterbury Café is part of the Randolph Sheppard Program, supported by the Division of the Blind and Visually Impaired.
