# Vermont Career Advancement Project

- Five-year grant funded by the Disability Innovation Fund
  - Rehabilitation Services Administration, US Department of Education
- Increase career advancement opportunities and experiences that result in IRCs and higher wages.
  - Focus on Earn-and-Learn pathways, such as registered apprenticeship programs.
- Systems-change for HireAbility
  - Develop framework of services that support career advancement
  - Expand career pathways across project partners

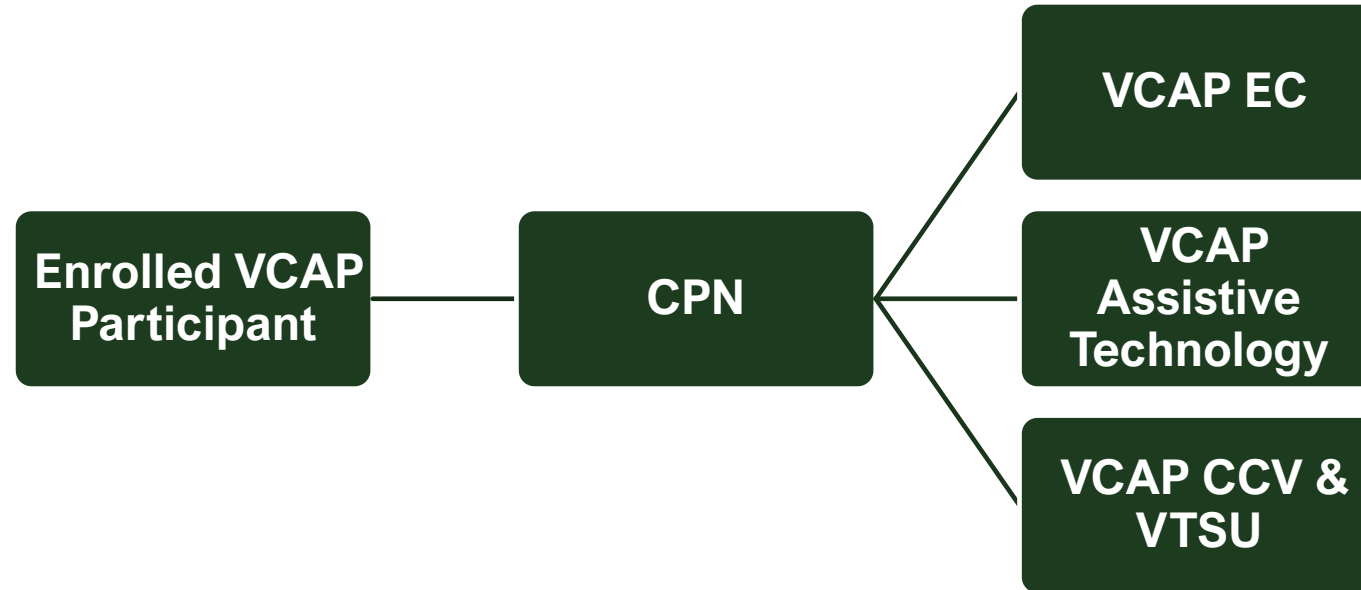

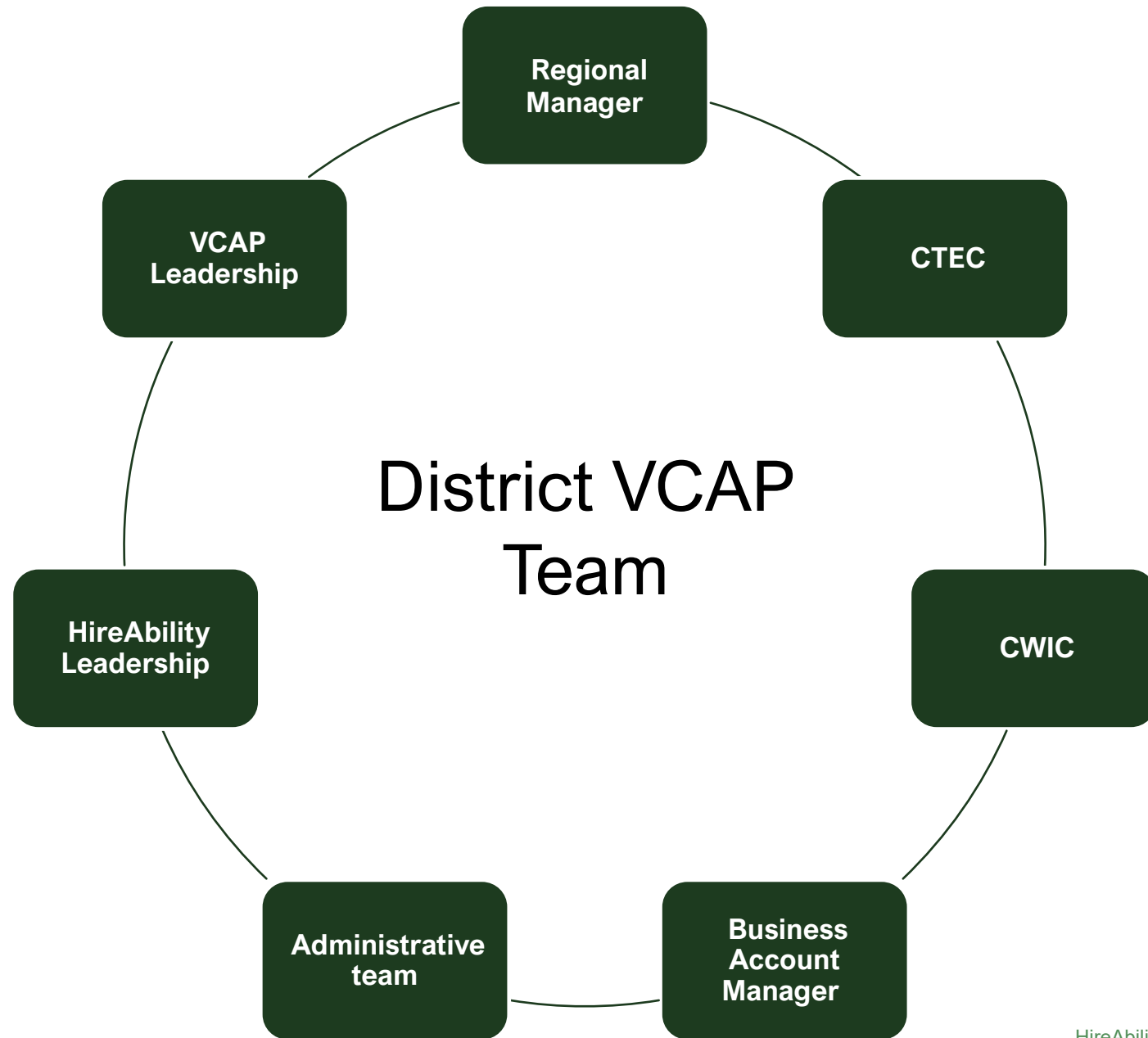
# VCAP structure

- VCAP is embedded in HireAbility.
- Career Pathway Navigators
  - Vocational counselors working on the project
  - Often partners with other roles such as BAM, CWIC, CTEC
- Enrolled VCAP Participants
  - HireAbility participants who have agreed to enroll in the study, pursue a career path leading to a credential, and work directly with the CPN
