What are the Common Performance Measures (CPM)?

- Measurable Skill Gains
 - The percentage of participants who, during a program year, are in an education or training program that leads to a recognized postsecondary credential or employment and who are achieving documented academic, technical, occupational, or other forms of progress, towards such a credential or employment.
 - This is not an exit-based measure
 - It is intended to capture important progressions through pathways that offer different services based on program purposes and participant needs.

CPMs continued...

- Employment Rate 2 & 4 quarters after program exit
 - What percentage of participants whose case has <u>closed</u> with HireAbility are employed two and four quarters after their case was closed (6 and 12 months after case closure)
 - These cases could have closed successfully OR unsuccessfully with HireAbility
- Median Earnings 2 quarters after program exit
